Registration details needed in the email are Name, Address, E-mail address, phone number. **Abstracts** should be no longer than 200 words (excluding title, authors and affiliations).

When registering and submitting an abstract please indicate types of presentation in order of preference (first, second, third preference):- spoken paper (12 minutes + 3 minutes for questions); spoken speed presentation (5 minutes); poster paper.

For a multi-authored paper/poster indicate the name of the presenter.

Invited speakers include, Louise Firth (University of Plymouth & University College Cork), Fernando Lima (University of Porto), Juan Sempere-Valverde (University of Seville & KAUST)

Presentations on all forms of limpet (living and extinct) will be accepted.

On Day 1 of the meeting there will be talks and an evening informal social gathering (venue to be announced). On Day 2 lunch and refreshments will be provided during the poster sessions.
